On arrival of the hijacked aircraft at Delhi Airport on 1st January, 2000, an anti-sabotage check was conducted by Bureau of Civil Aviation Security in association with the engineers of Indian Airlines and the aircraft was released to Indian Airlines on the same day. The aircraft was flown to its base i.e. Mumbai.
