FOREIGN INVESTMENT IN ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have received any proposals from foreign investors for construction of road in the country;
- (b) if so, the details of proposals received during the last three years till date, country-wise; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government on each proposal?

- (a) to (c) Government of Malaysia made two proposals for National Highways for undertaking projects on Build, Operate & Transfer (BOT) basis through their Construction Industry Development Board Inventions (CIDBI). These are
- (i) 4-laning of Tada-Nellore section of NH-5 and Vijayawada-Nandigama section of NH-9 in Andhra Pradesh, and
 - (ii) 8-laning of Delhi-Gurgaon section of NH-8 in Delhi and Haryana. The Government has approved the proposal at (i) and has not approved the proposal at (ii).
