(a) to (c): The Ministry of Power had asked the National Council of Applied Economic Research (NCAER) as a consultant to suggest legislative changes it considered necessary to accelerate the reform process in the power sector.

The NCAER has submitted for discussion a draft Electricity Bill to replace the existing three electricity laws (The Indian Electricity Act, 1910, The Electricity (Supply) Act, 1948 and The Electricity Regulatory Commissions Act, 1998).

Its copies have been circulated to all concerned for their comments, suggestions and advice to assist Government in taking a view on the proposed Bill.
