#### Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

(a) the norms to fix the royalty on coal;

(b) the quantity of production and amount of royalty received by coal producing States during each of the last ten years, State-wise.

(c) whether the Government have received requests for upward revision of royalty on coal;

(d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;

(e) the reaction of the Government thereto; and

(f) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

# Answer

#### MINISTER OF STATE FOR COAL (SHRI SYED SHAHNAWAZ HUSSAIN)

(a): Royalty on coal is fixed after taking into account all relevant factors such as the view points of the coal producing States, coal consumers and the over all interests of the economy.

The proviso to Section 9(3) of the Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 stipulates that no enhancement of royalty rate on minerals can be done more than once during any period of 3 years.

(b): The State-wise production of raw coal in Coal India Limited and Singareni Collieries Company Limited and the amount of royalty paid by Coal India Limited and Singareni Collieries CompanyLimited to various coal producing States during the last ten years are as under:-
