## Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Islanders of Southern Group of Islands in Andaman and Nicobarare facing lot of difficulties in inter-island services by ship;
- (b) whether the Government are proposing to purchase new ships for Andaman and Nicobar Islands to facilitate the passengers of Southern Groups of Islands;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV)

- (a) No, Sir. However, at times, difficulties are faced by people of southern group of Islands due to non-availability of the inter-island vessels viz., m.v. Chowra and mv Sentinel due to machinery breakdown and Annual Passenger Survey.
- (b)&(c) The following vessels are already proposed to be acquired for facilitating better passenger service in southern group of Islands:
- Sl.No. Type of vessel
- 1. Two 400 passenger vessels under construction, one each at M/s HDPEL (Kolkata) and M/s Alcock Ashdown (Gujarat)
- 2. Four 100 passenger vessel under construction at M/s Hindustan Shipyard Ltd., (Vizag)
- 3. Two 75 passenger cum 50 ton cargo vessel under construction at M/s Alcock Ashdown (Gujarat)
- 4. One 50 passenger Motor Launch under construction at M/s Inland Marine works, Port Blair.
