(a) to (d): Yes, Sir. The Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with IIT Delhi involving a total cost of Rs. 8.35 crores. Out of this Rs. 7.00 crores will be utilized for creating infrastructure at Jamnalal Bajaj Centre for Research Institute (JBCRI), Wardha, an important research and development institute functioning under the KVIC and Rs 1.35 crore for related activities at IIT, Delhi. The proposed role of IIT is to create a data base of all relevant rural and village level technology, to conduct training and orientation programme for transfer of technology and to provide services of professionals etc.
