Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government have decided to hike the prices of kerosene and LPG after dismantling of the administered pricing mechanism in April, 2002;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government propose to evolve some mechanism to avoid such hike; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a) & (b): As per the Government decisions of November 1997, subsidies on domestic LPG and Kerosene for public distribution system at 15% and 33.33% of the import parity respectively would be borne by the fiscal budget after dismantling of administered pricing mechanism (APM).
- (c): No, Sir.
- (d): As per the Government decisions of November 1997, prices of all petroleum products are to be moved towards import parity subject to the subsidies as per (a) & (b) above.
