- (a): There is no proposal at present to review the duty drawback rates.
- (b),(c)&(d): Several representations were earlier received from various individual garment exporters, number of garment export promotion organisations/associations as well as Apparel Export Promotion Council, seeking a review ofthe duty drawback rates announced on 1st June, 2001 for various categories of readymade garments. All these representations were duly considered and taking due note of the fresh data submitted, the duty drawback rates for all categories of readymade garments(including knitwears), were suitably revised upwards by a notification issued on 22nd June, 2001.
