(a) In order to improve the production and recoveries of oil and gas from Mumbai High North field, Oil & Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) carried out studies for its redevelopment, in consultation with international consultants M/s. Gaffney, Cline & Associates, an internationally reputed reservoir consulting firm in U.K. and the Directorate General of Hydrocarbons. The ensuing redevelopment plan conceived as a modular approach has been approved by the ONGC Board. No irregularity has come to the notice of Government in this regard.
