- (a) whether houses have not been constructed under IAY in Bihar;
- (b) whether the funds released under the schemes have not been spent so far;
- (c) if so, whether any enquiry has been conducted in this regard;
- (d) if so, the details and the outcome thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

MINISTER OF STATE FOR RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUBHASH MAHARIA)

(a) to (e) No, Sir. Funds released under the Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) are being spent by the Government of Bihar on the construction of houses. As per information supplied by the Government of Bihar, 165893 houses have been constructed under the IAY in 1999-2000. The Government of India released Rs. 29527.28 lakhsto the Government of Bihar as central allocation in 1999-2000 . No specific enquiry has been conducted by the Government of India either on the physical assets created or the financial achievements under the IAY.
