- (a) the number of Ayurvedic colleges at present, State- wise;
- (b) whether the Government propose to open Ayurvedic colleges in the country during 2000-2001;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, location-wise; and
- (d) the time by which these colleges are likely to be opened?

Answer

(a) At present, there are 185 Ayurvedic colleges in the country. State-wise details of these colleges are given at Annexure.

(b) to (d) The decision to open new Ayurvedic colleges rests with the concerned State Governments, who are guided by various factors including the need for more colleges and the availability of resources for establishing the infrastructure prescribed by the Central Council of Indian Medicine.
