THERMAL POWER PLANT IN U.P.

**Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether a proposal to set up a Thermal Power Plant at Koili Mohan Siyar in Ballia district, Uttar Pradesh was cleared ten years back and a survey for the plant has also been conducted;
- (b) if so, whether the Government propose to set up the same at the said site;
- (c) if so, the time by which it is likely to be done; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

(a) to (d) : No proposal for setting up a thermal power station at Koili Mohan Siyar in Ballia District, Uttar Pradesh has been received in Central Electricity Authority (CEA). (UPSEB) to instal 3x250 MW power station at Belthara Road in District Ballia was received in CEA on 8.11.1992. As the proposal was submitted without tieing up of any inputs such as water, fuel, environment, etc., UPSEB was requested in February, 1994 to do the needful and resubmit the scheme. There has been no response from UPSEB, thereafter.
