(c) & (d) Export of marine products during the first half of the current financial year touched US \$ 672.96 Million (provisional) as compared to US \$ 530.30 Million in the same period last year, reflecting a growth of 26.9%.

Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA) which implements various export promotion measures, coordinates with Department of Fisheries of various State Governments for undertaking activities like shrimp seed production, development of infrastructure, training of trainers etc. in various States. Government have recently extended to State Governments the facility of subsidy to set up laboratories for the detection of viral/bacterial infection in shrimp/fresh water prawn hatcheries.
