Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) Whether the representation of SCs and STs in Class I(Group-A) services stood only at 13.59% (SCs-10.38% and STs-3.21%) and in Class II (Group-B) services only at 14.41% (SCs 11.73% and STs 2.68%) as against 22.5% quota prescribed for them (15% for SCs and 7.5% in respect of STs) as on 1/1/1998 under Central Government;
- (b) If so, the total number of `posts` in (i) Class I(Group-A) category and (ii) Class II (Group -B) category and equivalentthereof under his Ministry; and
- (c) The number of persons belonging to (i) General (ii) SC(iii) STand (iv) OBC categories working againstthem including their respective percentage to such posts as ascertained in view of instructions as contained under para 5 of DOPTOM No.36012/2/96-Estt(Res) dated July 2, 1997?
