(a) to (e): A noutline of proposed draft Processed Food Development Bill has been drawn up by the Ministry of Food Processing Industries, which envisages inter-alia setting up of a Processed Food Development Authority to establish standards for Processed Foods. As the proposal is only in a preliminary stage details have not been worked out.
