- (a) whether Andhra Pradesh Government has approached Gujarat and Maharashtra Governments to purchase power from these States;
- (b) if so, whether any agreement has been signed to this effect; and
- (c) if so, the amount likely to be paid to each State and the quantum of power in Megawatts to be supplied to Andhra Pradesh?

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b) & (c):
- (i) Maharashtra has agreed to supply 200 MW power to Andhra Pradesh on round the clock basis. The rate of power will be Rs.2.45 per KWH for off-peak hours (22.00 Hrs. to 06.00 Hrs.) and Rs.2.80 per KWH for peak hours (06.00 Hrs. to 10.00 Hrs.).
- (ii) Gujarat has agreed to supply 100 MW to 200 MWpower to Andhra Pradesh @ Rs.3.00 per KWH for a period ofthree months as detailed below:-

100 MW from 06.00 Hrs. to 21.30 Hrs. 200 MW from 21.30 Hrs. to 06.00 Hrs.
