- (c) whether the Group has submitted its report; and
- (d) if so, the main recommendations/suggestions made by the Group?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (CH. VIDYASAGAR RAO)

(a)&(b): Yes, Sir. A Policy Planning Group was constituted to recommend measures to strengthen the financial set up of Delhi Police and some other Central Police Organizations.

(c)&(d): Yes, Sir. The main recommendations with regard to Delhi Police relate to delegation of enhanced financial powers to the Commissioner of Police, Delhi and other senior functionaries of Delhi Police, and strengthening of the accounting and audit set up in Delhi Police.
