(a)&(b) This Ministry has provided funds to West Bengal for the development of tribals.

(c)&)d) There is no State-wise allocation of funds under the Schemes implemented by this Ministry. Funds are released on the basis of proposals received from the concerned State Govts. and on receipt of the utilization certificates of grants already released. No fund has so far been released to West Bengal for the current year 2000-2001 as the proposals are awaited. Details of Ifunds released during the last three years to West Bengal for the development of tribals are given at Annexure-I.
