PM and other leaders conveyed that India will fully participate in the reconstructi on and rehabilitati on of Afghanistan. Home Minister proposed that India and Japan could set up a joint working

group on terrorism

and also sign an agreement on mutual legal assistance in criminal matters. He took note of our suggestions and agreed to follow up.
