Dave, Chairman UTi, to evolve a suitable framework for regulation of all mutual funds including those to be set up in the private and joint sectors. The regulatory framework envisaged will cover, interalia, aspects like establishment, management, investment objectives, pricing, disclosures, distribution policy and statements of accounts of mutual funds. The members of the Group include representatives of Securities and Exchange Board of India, Reserve Bank of India, Government of India, mutual funds and subject matter special lists. The Report of the Study Group on Guidelines for Mutual Funds has already been received.
