- (a) the total number of Dealer Selection Boards in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the details of guidelines issued to them;
- (c) whether the functioning of Dealer Selection Boards had stopped temporarily;
- (d) if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the time by which all the DSB's are likely to be made functional?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM & NATURAL GAS (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a): The Statewise number of Dealer Selection Boards (DSBs) in the country is given in the Annexure.
- (b): The important features of the guidelines issued by the Government for selection retail outlet dealers/LPG distributors/SKO-LDC dealers are given below:-

The locations for setting up dealerships/ distributorships included in the Marketing Plans, are advertised by the Oil Companies inviting applications from eligible candidates. After the scrutiny of the applications, the eligible candidates are interviewed by the DSBs for selection on merit. The following criteria have been prescribed for assessing the inter-se merit of the candidates:-

- (a) Personality, Business ability and salesmanship.
- (b) Capability to arrange finances.
- (c) Educational qualification and general level of intelligence.
- (d) Capability to provide infrastructure and facilities (land, godown, showroom, etc.)
- (e) General assessment.

As per the guidelines, reservation of dealerships/ distributorships for different sections of the society will be as under:-

1) Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes(SCs/STs) - 25%
2) Physically Handicapped Persons (PH) - 5
3) Paramilitary/Police/Govt. Personnel (PMP) - 8%
4) Defence Personnel (DC) - 8%
5) Freedom Fighters (FF) - 2%
6) Outstanding Sportspersons (OSP) - 2%
7) Open(O) - 50%
```

(c)to(e): Pending inquiry into complaints received against selection of dealers/distributors, the selection process by the DSBs in Jammu & Kashmir, Allahabad-I, Lucknow-I, Agra-I, Agra-II, Himachal Pradesh, Bhopal-I, Bhopal-II, Jabalpur-II, Jabalpur-II, Raipu Patna-IV and Goa was suspended in March/April, 2001.

All interviews by the DSBs, Chennai-I, Chennai-II, Coimbatore and Madurai have been put on hold temporarily.

The selection process by the DSBs, Allahabad-I and Patna-IV has been resumed w.e.f. 22.9.2001 and 26.9.2001 respectivelyEfforts are being made to enable these DSBs to resume the selection process.
