- (d) whether a group of Ministers has been set up to look into the speedy implementation of the new plan; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the number of villages likely to be electrified each year upto 2005 under this scheme?

- (a) & (b): Government has decided to grant interest subsidy of Rs.16.67 crores for electrification of 415 Tribal villages and 2440 Dalit Bastis during the year 2000-2001.
- (c): State-wise details of electrification of tribal villages and dalit bastis are given in Annexure-I.
- (d) & (e): The Group of Ministers consisting of Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission, Minister of Finance, Minister of Power, Minister of Information Technology and Minister of Tribal Affairs has been set up. The Group of Ministers may reviewall the existing schemes relating to electrification of Tribal villages, Dalit bastis and benefiting other weaker sections and suggest modifications for accelerating the pace of electrification.
