- (b) Kanha Tiger Reserve was launched in the year 1972-73 under the Project Tiger Scheme of the Government of India Ever since its inception, Kanha Tiger Reserve has been receiving budget/grants from the State Government as well as from the Government of India and Project Tiger under various Central and State sponsored schemes.
