Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT AND POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Karnataka Urban Water Supply and Drainage Board (KUWSDB) has chalked out an action plan of Rs.1,033 crore to ensure water supply to all towns/cities, besides underground drainage scheme in all the towns at a cost of Rs.2,973 crore;

(b) if so, the details of the plans;

(c) whether the Union Government have agreed to provide funds for implementing the scheme; and

(d) if so, the extent to which the Union Government is likely to provide funds in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR URBAN DEVELOPMENT & POVERTY ALLEVIATION (SHRI BANDARU DATTATREYA)

(a): No, Sir, this Ministry is not aware whether the Karnataka Urban Water Supply and Drainage Board has chalked out an action plan of Rs.1,033 crore to ensure water supply to all towns/cities, besides undertaking underground drainage scheme in all the towns at a cost of Rs.2,973 crore. However, the HUDCO has informed that it has sanctioned 29 water supply schemes in Karnataka at a project cost of Rs.428.18 crores involving HUDCO loan of Rs.277.92 crores.
