- (b) Defence Research & Development Establishment (DRDE) Gwalior, a laboratory of DRDO has planned courses of 4 days duratior starting from last week of November, 2001. The course will have theoretical and practical sessions to cover all aspects of the problem.
- (c) The training will provide awareness and impart skills to the participants to manage various aspects of the problem. Further dissemination of information will remove fears from the minds of authorities and the public.
