(a), b) and (c): In the recent past, requests have been received from Government of West Bengal regarding increase, in services between Bagdogra and Kolkata. In the SummerSchedule Indian Airlines was operating three days in a week service between Kolkata and Bagdogra. The frequency of operation of this service has been increased to five days a week in the Winter Schedule effective 28th October, 2001.
