## Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Public Sector oil companies are spending huge funds for locating more oil reserves than the estimated oil reserves in the country;
- (b) if so, whether the cost of exploration of oil is rising as a result thereof;
- (c) if so, the amount out of the estimated funds spent thereon during the last two years; and
- (d) the estimated/actual amount spent on pumping out oil during the said period?

## **Answer**

Minister of State in the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas and Minister of State in the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs (Shri Santosh Kumar Gangwar)

- (a) & (b) The two upstream National Oil Companies(NOCs), i.e.,Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Ltd. (ONGC) and Oil India Ltd. (OIL make investments as envisaged in the Plans for oil and gas discoveries in the country. The cost of finding oil and oil equivalent of gas per Metric Tonne for these NOCs during 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 was in the ranges of Rs. 385-450 and Rs. 220-430 respectively.
- (c) & (d): The actual expenditure of the two NOCs on exploration and production of oil and gas during the last two years is as under:-
