Will the Minister of INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) year-wise/post-wise/category-wise number of posts reserved for disabled/physically handicapped persons in his Ministry and departments under his Ministry, during the last three years;
- (b) year-wise/post-wise/category-wise number of posts for disabled /physically handicapped persons lying vacant as on October 31, 2001; and
- (c) year-wise/post-wise/category-wise number of disabled /physically handicapped persons given employment on such posts?

Answer

MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI PF MAHAJAN)

- (a): One Group `C` post has been identified in Ministry of Information Technology in the year 2000 for an Orthopaedically Handicapped person. As regards, Attached and Subordinate Offices under Ministry of Information Technology, 5 post each in Group `C` & `D` posts have been identified during the last three years.
- (b): One post of Group `C` in Ministry of Information Technology and two posts of Group `D` in Attached and Subordinate Offices under MIT are lying vacant as on October 31, 2001.
- (c): Attached and Subordinate Offices: In National Informatics Centre(NIC), 8 posts(Group `C` 5, Group `D` 3) have been filled up. In Standardisation Testing & Quality Certification(STQC) Directorate five disabled/physically handicapped persons have been appointed in different Groups.
