- (a) whether the Government have decided to deploy some additional special battalions of the Central Security Forces to deal with Pak-supported terrorism in Jammu and Kashmir particularly on the international border;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said decision is likely to be implemented ?

(a)to(c) Central Security Forces are made available to the State Government to assist them in maintaining public order and tackling militancy terrorism. The levels of deployment depends upon overall security scenario in the country and the availability of Central Security Forces. Accordingly, Central Security Forces are being made available to the Government of J&K keeping in view the availability of forces and the prevailing security situation which is reviewed from time to time. Within J&K the Unified Headquarters keep reviewing the deployment which has to be dynamic keeping in view the changing situations. This is a continuing process.
