(a) to (c): A proposal for setting up of Kota Thermal Power Station Unit-6 Stage-IV (1x195 MW) has been received in Central Electricity Authority (CEA) in June, 2001 foraccord of Techno-economic clearance. The scheme could not considered for techno-economic clearance by the CEA as essential inputs such as coal linkage, availability of water and funding arrangements for execution of the project have yet not been tied up by the State authorities.
