- (a) The Ministry of Rural Development has recently forwarded a concept note for seeking World Bank support for the ongoing Government of India scheme on rural road connectivity, namely Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY).
- (b) & (c) The said proposal is at the stage of preliminary discussions with the World Bank. As such, presently there is no commitment from the World Bank on the funding of the said proposal.
