JOINT VENTURE PRIVATISATION OF SALEM STEEL PLANT

- (a) whether the Government have proposed to run the Salem Steel Plant in Joint Venture with SAIL;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the people of Tamil Nadu requested the Union Government regarding continuation of SAIL in Tamil Nadu; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE FOR STEEL (SHRI BRAJA KISHORE TRIPATHY)

(a)to(d): The financial and business restructuring package for Steel Authority of India Ltd. (SAIL) that was approved by the Government in February, 2000 inter alia, envisaged formation of a Joint Venture (JV) for Salem Steel Plant (SSP) with a view to reviving the plant. Accordingly, SAIL is taking steps to select a suitable joint venture partner. There has been some opposition against the divestment of SSP from the employees' unions and political parties of Tamil Nadu. However, SAIL has decided to go ahead with the JV exercise.
