- (b) the number of small scale units set up/revived in the State by the Small Industry Development Bank of India by providing loans during the last three years, year-wise;
- (c) whether Small Industry Development Bank of India proposes to extend its activities in the State; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

VASUNDHARA RAJE)

(a): Small Industry Development Bank of India (SIDBI) extends financial assistance to small scale sector for setting up new and existing projects and for modernization and diversification through direct and indirect finance schemes which are in operation on an all-India basis including in the State of Bihar.
