## Will the Minister of SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government are considering to introduce norms for revival of sick SSI units;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Reserve Bank of India has laid down any norms that the banks should follow in the rehabilitation of SSI units; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

## **Answer**

(a) to (d): Based on the recommendations of the Working group constituted by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) under the Chairmanship of Shri S.S. Kohli, the then Chairman of Indian Banks` Association, the RBI has drawn up revised guidelines for rehabilitation of Sick Small Scale Industrial (SSI) units, which include inter-alia change in the definition of sick SSI units, norms for deciding on their viability, etc. The RBI has circulated the revised guidelines on 16th January, 2002 to all the Banks for implementation.
