## Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government have asked the States to locate Pakistani citizens overstaying in the country;
- (b) if so, the details in this regard indicating the exact number of Pak citizens, State-wise;
- (c) the number of Pak citizens about whom there was no reliable information as on 31.1.2002, State-wise;
- (d) whether the Union Government have provided any assistance to the States in this regard;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the extent to which the States have been able to locate them and the Centre has deported them to Pakistan during each of the last three years and till date?

## Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI CH. VIDYASAGAR RAO)

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b) & (c): A Statement containing this information as on 31.12.2001 is attached.
- (d) & (e): The powers under Section 3(2) (c) of the Foreigners Act, 1946 to detect and deport foreign nationals including Pakistani nationals, staying in India unauthorisedly have been entrusted to the State Governments and UT Administrations. Besides, administrative instructions are issued to them from time to time to launch special drives to detect Pak nationals staying illegally in the country for their immediate deportation. The State Governments perform these functions on behalf of the Central Government and expenditure incurred by the States on this account is reimbursable.
- (f): The number of Pak nationals detected and deported during the last three years are as under:-
