## Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government are aware of the number of major accidents occuring daily on the National Highway between Chengalpattu and Villupuram in Tamil Nadu due to bad condition of Road; and
- (b) if so, the action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to improve the condition of National Highway in this stretch?

## **Answer**

- (a) No data is available with regard to cases of accidents on this road due to bad condition of the road.
- (b) In order to enhance the safety and improve the efficiency of vehicular movement, Chengalpattu-Villupuram section of National Highway-45 in Tamil Nadu is proposed to be upgraded by widening it to four-lanes divided carriageway facility. The work of 4-laning on Chengalpattu-Tindivanam sub-section has already been awarded.
