(a) to (f) Assistance from WHO is provided on a calendar year basis every biennium. During the two biennium, 1998-1999 and 2000-2001, 7 projects were taken up under Health and Sanitation as per Annexure I.

WHO assistance is available for providing technical support on going programme activities in the nature of technical consultancies and expertise; small equipment; survey studies and research projects; training fellowships etc. Since funding is available only on a biennium basis, all activities taken up with WHO assistancehave to be implemented within one year of the completion of the biennium. Information regarding unspent amounts, if any, are known only in the following year.

Under the Health and Sanitation Projects, training; developmento f guidelines in solid waste management with community participation; waste management in hospitals; surveillance and status report on water quality etc. were some of the activities taken up. As the activities taken up with WHO funding are catalytic in nature, no evaluation of WHO assistance for these projects has been undertaken.
