- (i) disseminating information about the scheme and the procedures for obtaining the benefits under it;
- (ii) monitoring and following up the disbursal of the benefits under the various components of scheme;
- (iii) periodic submission of status of utilisation of funds under the scheme to the Central Government.
- (e)&(f) No, Sir. The Balika Samriddhi Yojana is a centrally sponsored scheme to extend 100% central assistance to States/UTs to provide benefits to the eligible girl children.
