(a) to (d): A decision has been taken to set up a Centre for Civil Aviation Security for functioning as the apex aviation security institution within the country, being a think-tank for innovation in the field of aviation security, developing suitable training modules after Training Needs Analysis, and also for international cooperation. Details of the project and estimated costs have not been finalised yet. The Centre would collaborate with other countries in areas of felt aviation security related needs.
