(a)&(b): Guidelines were issued for introduction of conducive policies by State Governments for power generation from Non-Conventional Energy Sources, including wind power generation. The Guidelines pertain to fixation of tariff for purchase of electricity by State Electricity Boards, alongwith annual escalation; wheeling and banking; and third party sale of power generated from renewable energy based power projects.
