- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The Comptroller and Auditor General has in a review relating to Non-Formal Education Programme raised anumber of issues that had come to its notice and had sought the Ministry's response to audit observations.
- (c) As the issues raised by the Comptroller and Auditor General primarily related to implementation of the Non-Formal Education Programme by the State Governments, the StateGovernments have been asked to send their comments. The Scheme of providing Financial Assistance to State Governments/VoluntaryAgencies under the NonFormal Education has since been discontinued w.e.f.1.4.2001.
