Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV)

- (a): The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) established by an Act oParliament has been empowered to coordinate Technical Education system for the subjects in Engineering & Technology and Architech and Pharmacy, Hotel Management & Catering Technology and Applied Arts & Crafts. The Agriculture subject has not been included under AICTE Act.
- (b) & (c): Do not arise.
- (d): Under the scope for AICTE Act it may not be possible for the Agriculture Ministryto accord Agriculture Education, a technical status.
