(a) to (d): During the year 2001-02, Annual Plans for Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) have been sanctioned for 19 districts of Rajasthan, namely, Alwar, Bhilwara, Jhalawar, Jhunjhunu, Kota, Nagaur, Sikar, Sirohi, Sri Ganganagar, Tonk, Churu, Dausa, Jaipur, Bharatpur, Dholpur, Bundi, Karauli, Swaimadhampur & Hanumangarh. The remaining districts would be covered under the programme based on the proposals received from the State Government.
