(a) & (b): No, Sir.

(c) & (d): UGC formulates its plan and programmes in accordance with the requirement of universities; wherever necessary, consultation with State Governments is done. It provides development and maintenance expenditure to Central Universities and development grants and other grants to eligible institutions of higher learning. The thrust areas of development identified for Xth Five Year Plan of UGC, inter-alia, are: development of universities, enhancing access and equity, promotion of relevance, promotion of quality and excellence, improvement in management and efficiency of higher education, strengthening scientific research and provision for Engineering & Technology subjects.
