(a)&(b): Modernisation of major ports in the country is an ongoing process involving a slew of measures which includes upgradation/conversion of existing conventional berths to suit emerging requirements; construction of new berths; upgradation of cargo handling equipment and maintenance procedures; redesigning and upgradation of internal road network and circulation systems where required; upgradation of storage facilities and other port infrastructure coupled with modern management practices. These measures are expected to contribute towards cost effective services and enhancement of service quality in the major ports.
