STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) ,(b), (c), (d) & (e) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 648 FOR ANSWE THE LOK SABHA ON 11-05-2000.

(a), (b), (c), (d) & (e):The Central Issue Price (CIP) of imported RBD Palmolein being supplied to States/U.Ts for supply through the Public Distribution System has been reduced with effect from 24.4.2000 to Rs.18,000/- per tonne in case of supplies made in bulk, i.e., loose and Rs.20,000/- per tonne in case of supplies made in 15 Kg. tins. This reduction is applicable uniformly to all States/U.Ts. The CIP is uniform and as such there is no difference in pricesfor different States as far as Government of India is concerned. As the PDS scheme is a part of the poverty alleviation programme, this reduction is expected to provide further relief to the target group.
