- (c): Detailed syllabi are laid down for the training of both Civil Defence and Home Guards volunteers. The Civil Defence Courses cover all the skills required for example communication, rescue, unexploded bomb reconnaissance and reporting service, casualty service, camouflage and concealment, fire fighting etc. Home Guards are given basic training in drill (with and without arms), weapons training, fire discipline, crowd control, field craft, patrolling, map reading, fire fighting, rescue, first aid, flood relief etc.
