- (c) whether the Government propose to formulate any plan for converting the tribal areas of Maharashtra into green belts; and
- (d) if so, the time by which the said plan is likely to be implemented?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF WATER RESOURCES (SMT. BIJOYA CHAKRAVARTY)

- (a) & (b) Yes, Sir. The Central Ground Water Board undertakes drilling of bore holes in various parts of the country, including tribal areas, under its ground water exploration programme. The State of Gujarat is also covered under this programme. State-wise number of bore holes drilled by CGWB upto 31st March, 2001 in tribal areas of the country is given in enclosed statement.
- (c) Ministry of Water Resources has no plan for converting the tribal areas of Maharashtra into green belt.
- (d) Does not arise.
