- (a): The number of Delhi Police personnel against whom cases of corruption were registered during the period under reference upto 15th February, 2000 was 25 which included three gazetted officers. Whereas the investigation in these cases is in progress, 21 of these officials have been placed under suspension.
- (b): The steps taken to remove corruption include close watch over police personnel suspected of doubtful integrity; and imposition of exemplary punishment on those found guilty so as to act as a deterrent against corrupt practices.
