- (c) the action taken or proposed to be taken in this regard?

**Answer**

(b) & (c): A statement indicating the proposals received from various States Governments/Union Territories for Integrated Infrastructural Development (IID) Centres and eventually sanctioned including nine projects which have been abandoned by the State Governments/Union territories concerned is at Annexure-A. Three more proposals for setting up IID Centres one each in District Cachar of Assam, District Lunglei of Mizoram and District Krishna of Andhra Pradesh have been received and are being examined with reference to the parameters of the IID Scheme.
